Referrals to Licensed Child Care

The Resource Connection provides free referrals to licensed child care homes and centers in Amador and Calaveras Counties. We provide information on child care options to help you make the best choices when selecting child care for your children; however, we do not make recommendations.

Need help paying for child care?

We offer several programs that provide assistance to help income-eligible parents pay for child care. Families may qualify if they are income eligible, have a qualifying family need and meet program requirements. We administer a California Alternative Payment Program, Cal Works Child Care, and a California Family Child Care Program (Amador only). The CEL is an online list of families waiting for child care assistance in Amador and Calaveras Counties. We use this list when we enroll families in our subsidy programs and we encourage other state funded child care programs in either county to use the list when they have openings for no or low cost child care.
